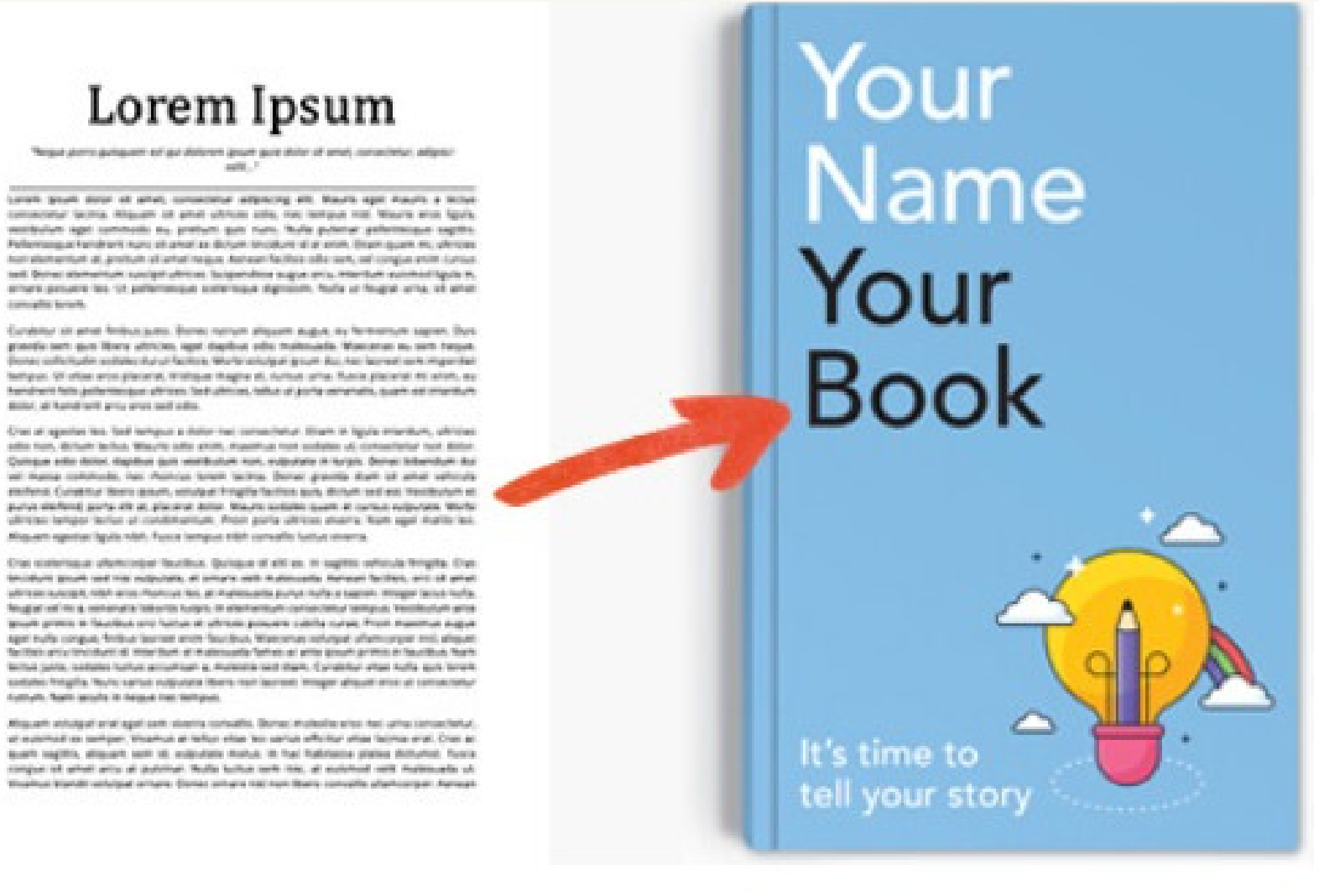
Authors will be working alongside publishing professionals, designers, illustrators, project managers and marketing consultants. Authors have complete autonomy on the final product, from cover design to editing, as well as the price of their work.





The author retains 100% of the publishing rights to the book.

Publishing Process.



- **Consulting Evaluation:** Evaluation is based on the content of the author's published book. After passing the evaluation, quotes will be made according to the amount of text, number of pages, cover, etc.
- **Sign the contract:** the type of book, the completion time, and declare the ISBN (International Book Number)
- **Author submits the full publication to the editorial department**
- **The editorial department checks the text and writes list of potential revisions**
- **Review of illustrations that go along with the text (if applicable)**
- **Revisions continue (with ongoing communication between author and editorial department)**
- **Final editorial check**
- **Text is published and printing begins**

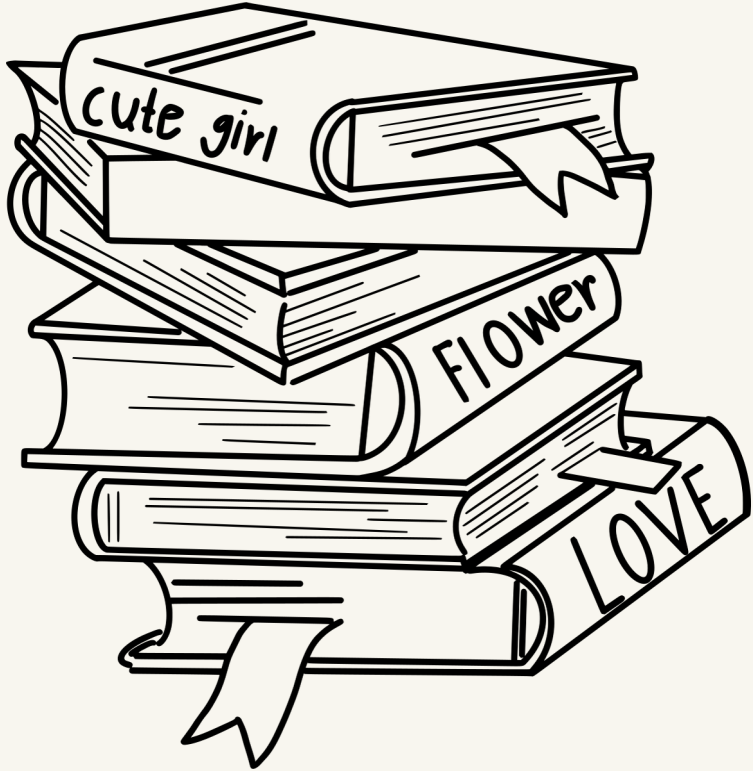

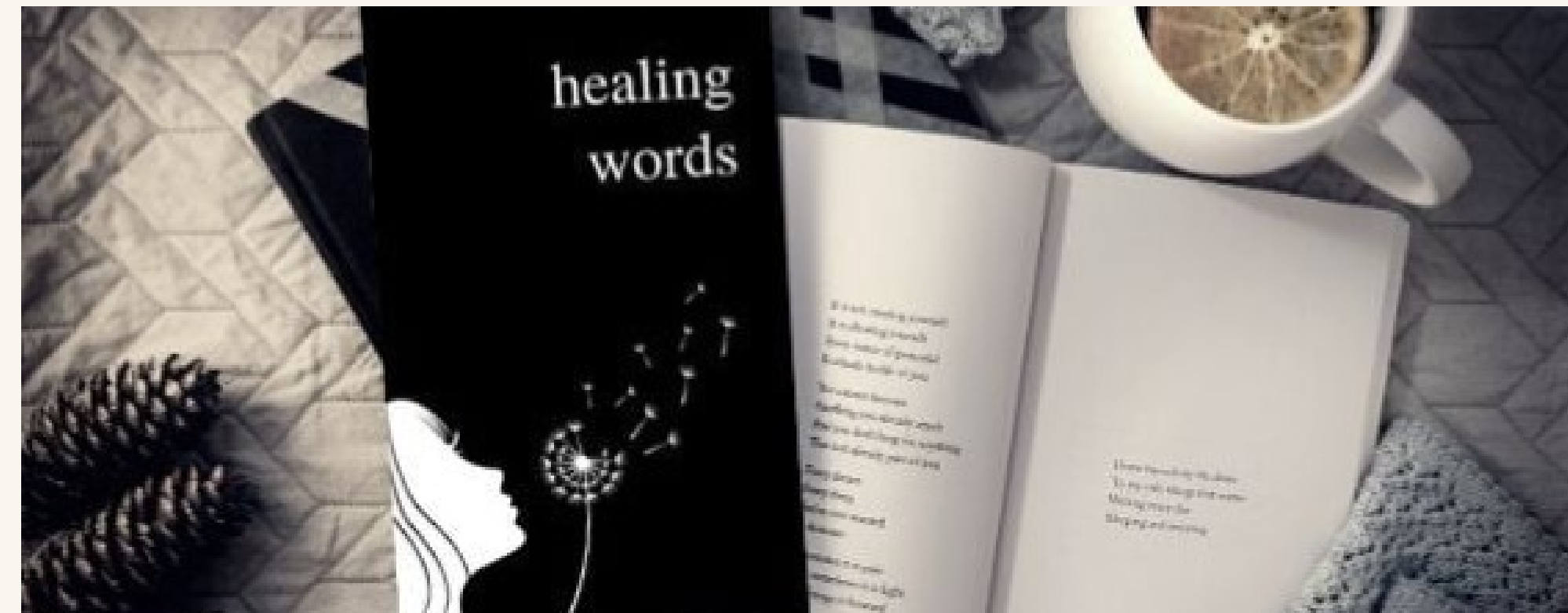

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Project 1: Creative Hands

Materials: HB pencil, colour crayons, markers

Hands are the tools of the mind. To develop their cognitive skills, children need to play and touch.

Keeping this fact in mind, this project has been designed for children to explore their own hands in a playful manner. Children will learn to trace the outline of their own hands, orienting the traces in different ways, imagining different animals or creatures.

Steps:

- 1) Place your hand on a sheet of paper any way you like.
- 2) Trace your hand.
- 3) Look at the shape and imagine what it looks like: is it a bird, a dog, a flower or an elephant? There are so many shapes and creatures that you can create!

Once it is done add colours and shapes inside and around the outline to make it bright, lively and interesting.

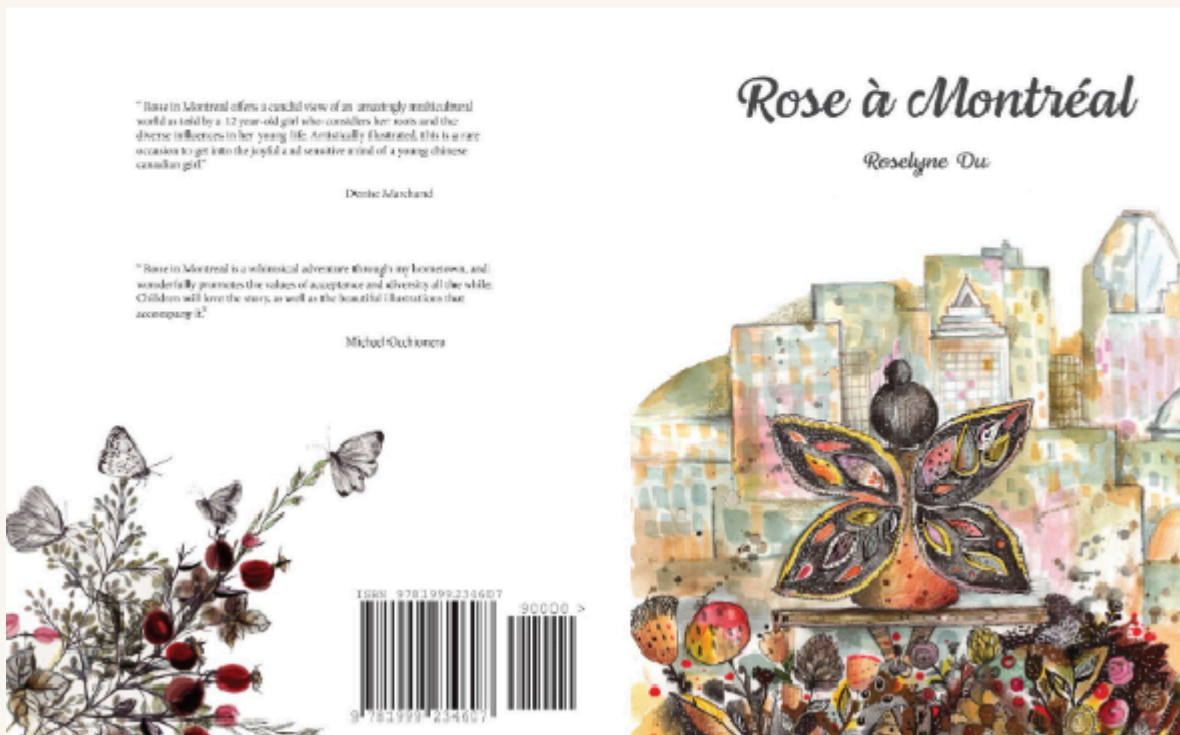
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In addition to providing publishing services for adult authors, we also publish a large number of children's picture books and stories.

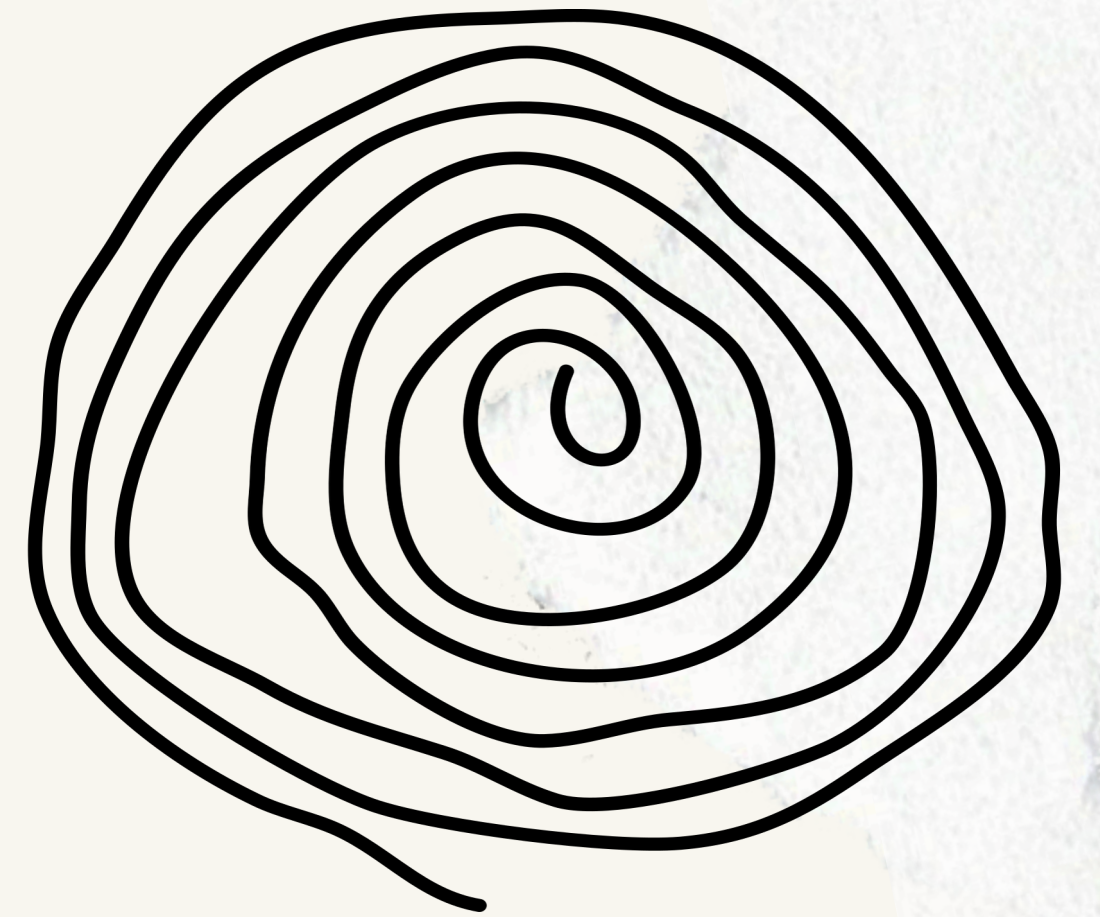

They went to the beach in the morning, and it was a super sunny day. The best day to surf! Maddie was already taking her surfboard to the ocean the moment they got there.

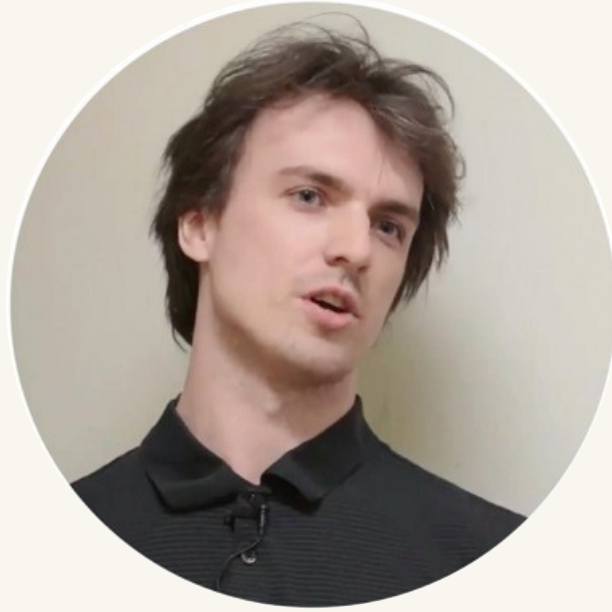

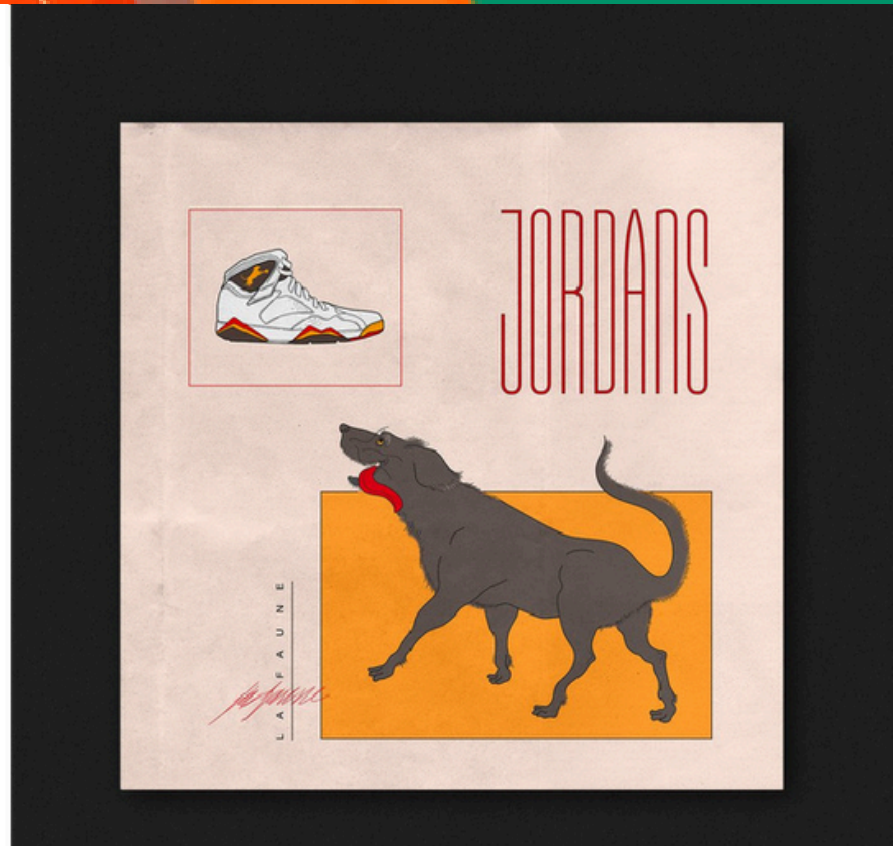
